Maths: TT Rock Stars / Numbots

- Individual login and password
- Highly effective in engaging pupils and developing quick recall skills
- Complete online security with no way of sharing any personal information



Accelerated Reader

- KS2 reading scheme only
- Promotes reading for pleasure
- Individual login and password
- Star Test and Quizzes test comprehension after each book is read
- A reading range (ZPD) is given after each test to guide children in choosing books that provide challenge
- Rewards linked to the scheme, chosen by the children
- Parent Workshop coming soon!

Reader

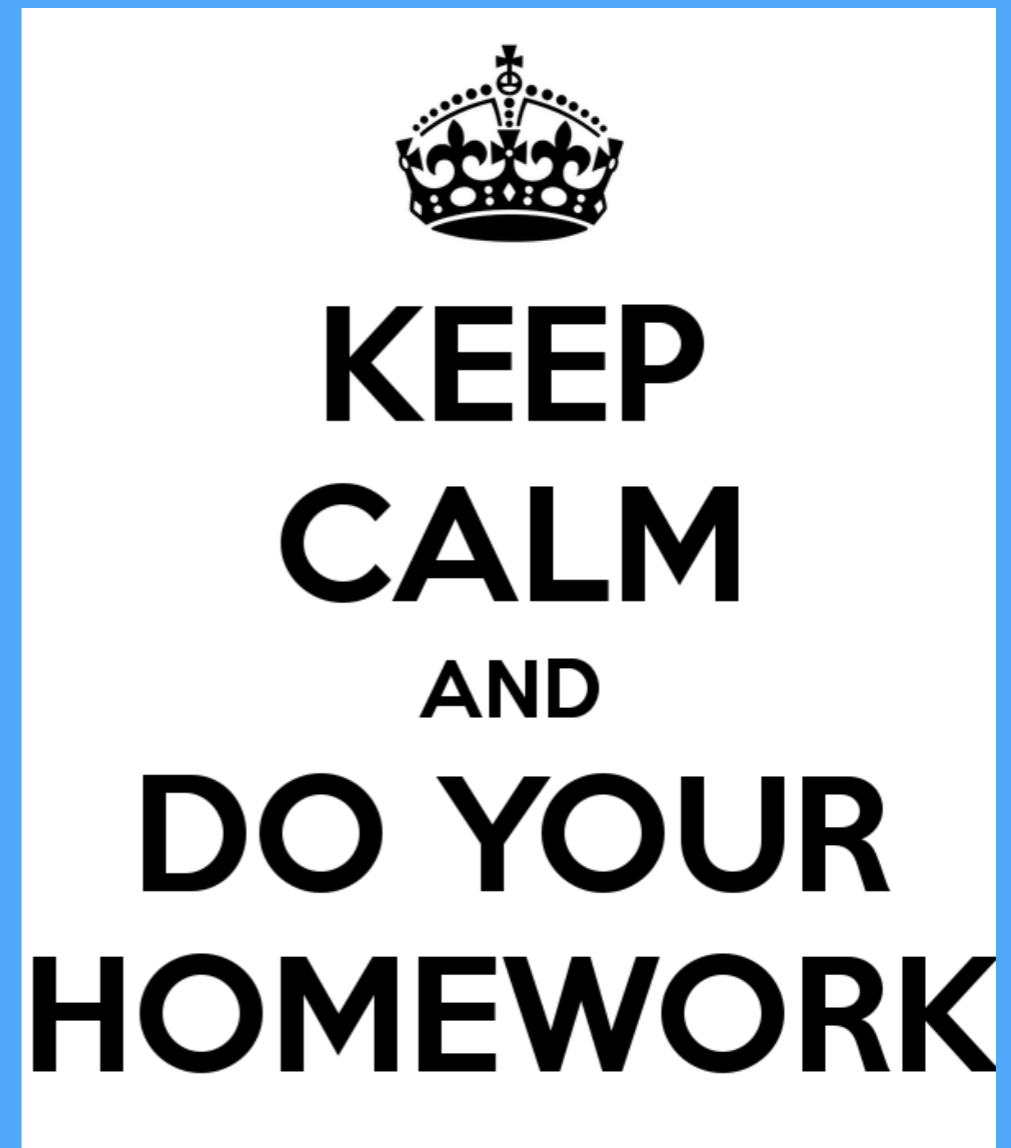
Lexia

- Based on individual needs
- Used as an enhancement to reading to address gaps and accelerate learning
- Phonics focused
- Access at home and in school
- Linked to a reward system



Homework

- Google Classroom – individual login
- Weekly Spellings, English and Maths homework
- Diaries – need to be signed daily and children to read for a minimum of 10 minutes
- SATs companion
- Creative grid are provided with each theme. This is optional.

Trips, Visitors and Residential

- All year groups go on a minimum of one curriculum linked trip per term.

Lancot Bank

- Tuesdays 8:30 – 8:55 in Orchard Class

Joining and saving will be simple and straightforward:

- A single form can be completed by a parent or guardian – it must signed at school
- There are no joining fees for a School Saver, just a first deposit – if possible at least £1
- All School Savers will receive a passbook which will be kept safe in school
- All School Savers will receive a Percy Piggy Bank to help them save at home



PE

- Year 6 PE sessions are on a Tuesday and Friday.
- PE kit is: navy shorts & white non-buttoning T-shirt. In winter - plain navy joggers/ leggings, plain navy jumper/ sweatshirt. Plimsolls/ trainers.
- Pupils are to attend school in their PE kit and wear for the day.
- No earrings. Pupils need to be able to removed them or should not wear them to school on PE days.

Clubs

- Dance (external dance expert), Nerf, Football, Art, Choir, Science, Detective, HangSwing&Climb – many more often chosen by Lancot pupils
