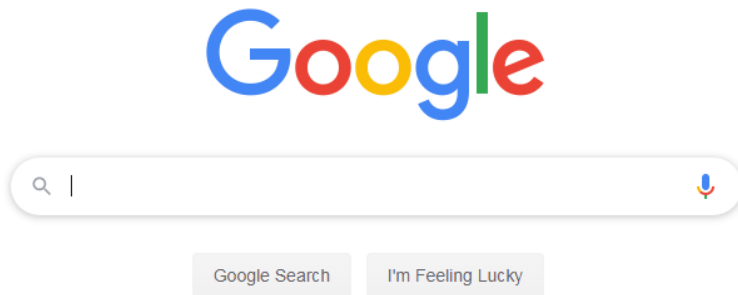



## Guide to Google Classroom

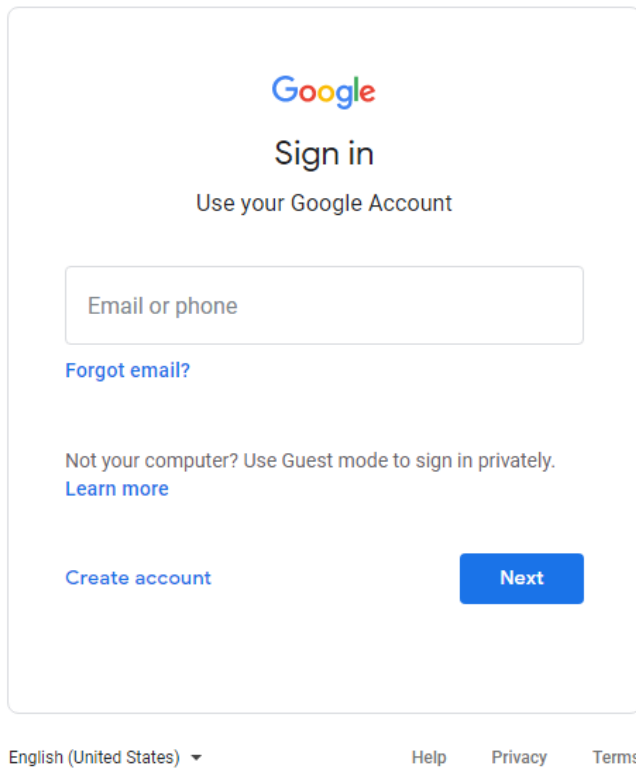
1. Using a laptop, PC, iPad or mobile device. Launch your internet browser (Google Chrome would be best).
2. Using a Google search engine, search for *Google Classroom*



3. Select the web link shown here.

4. In the box type in your child's personal email address that will end with *@lancotschool.co.uk*

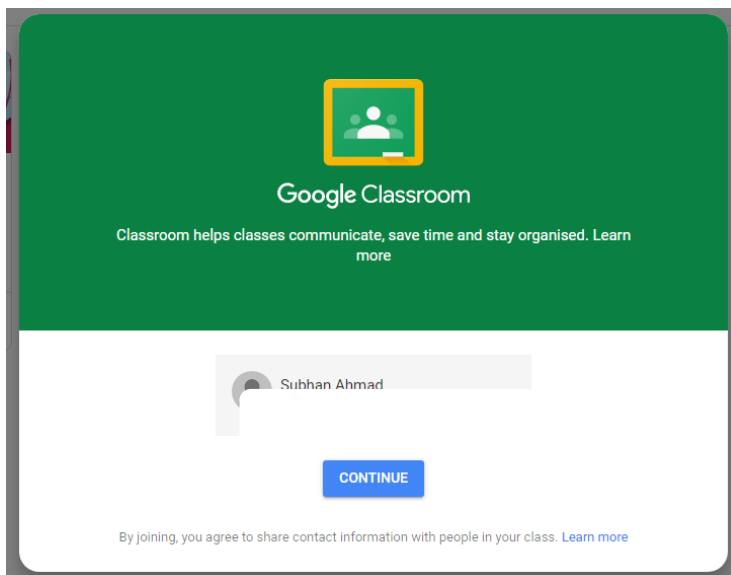


5. Press *Next*

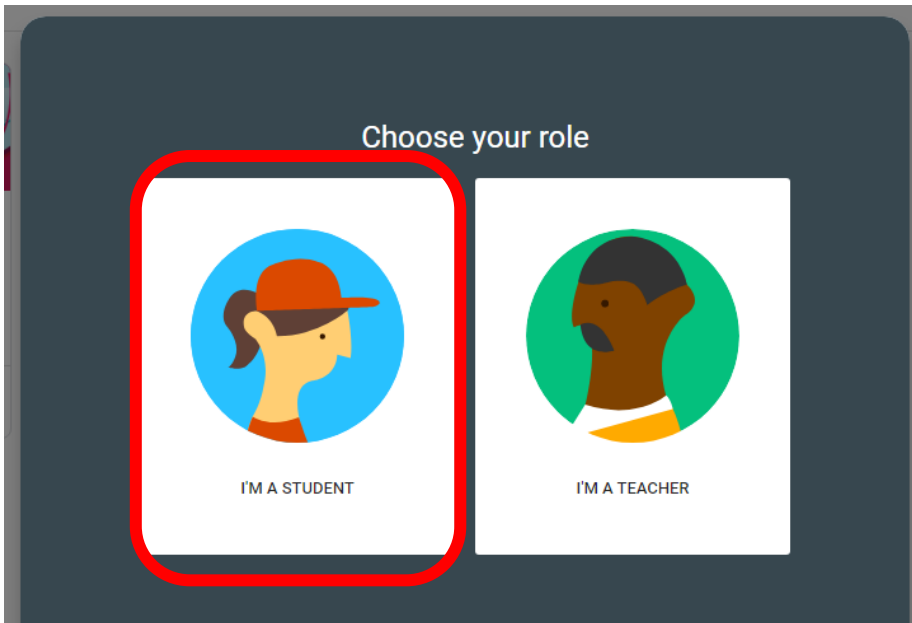
6. Type in your child's password.

7. Press *Next*

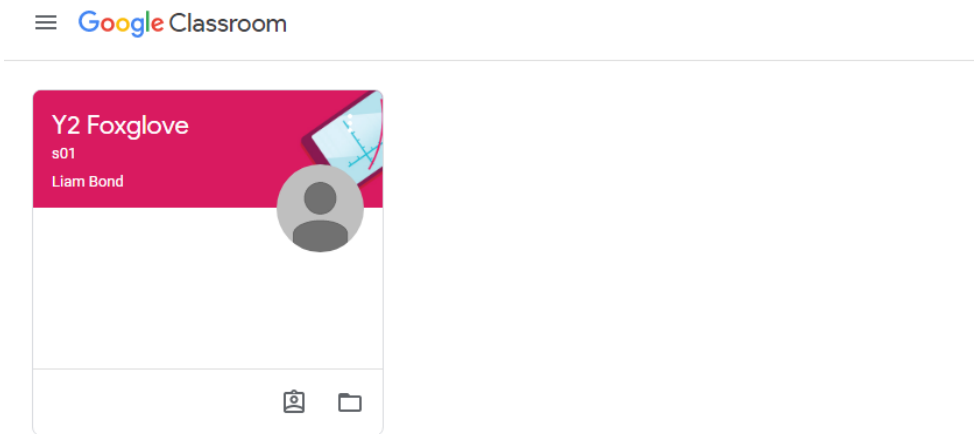
8. To gain access simply select *continue*



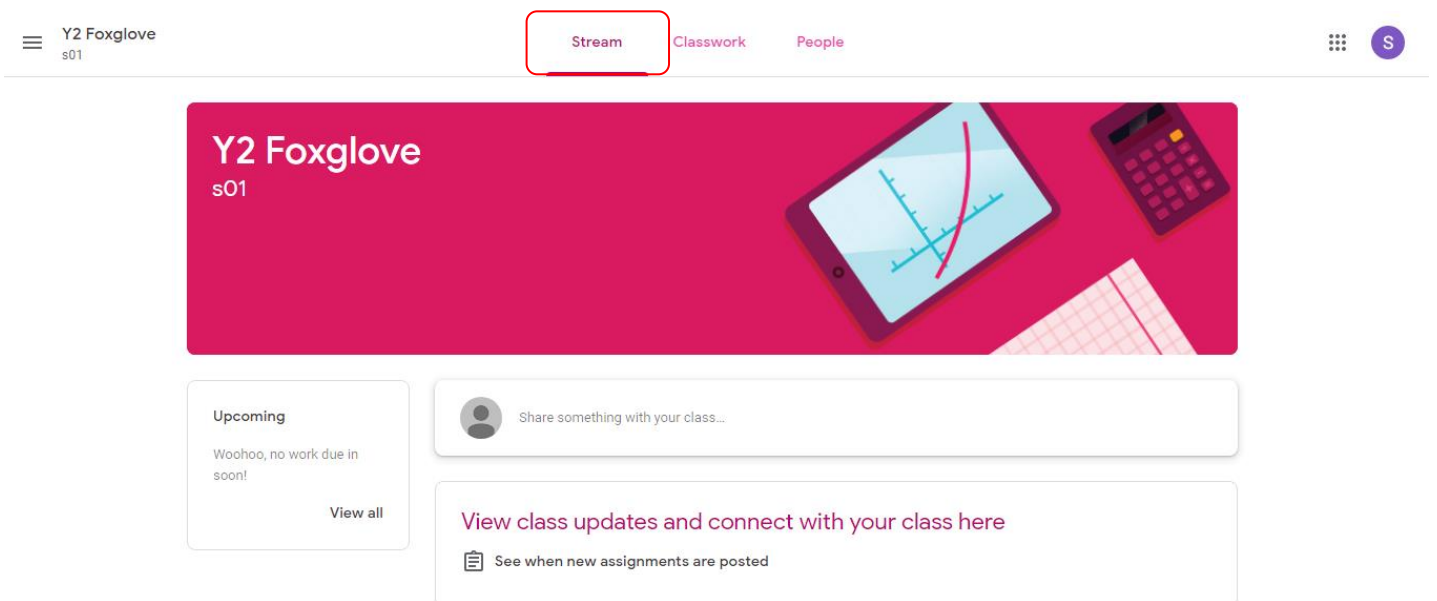
9. Select the *I'm a student option*.



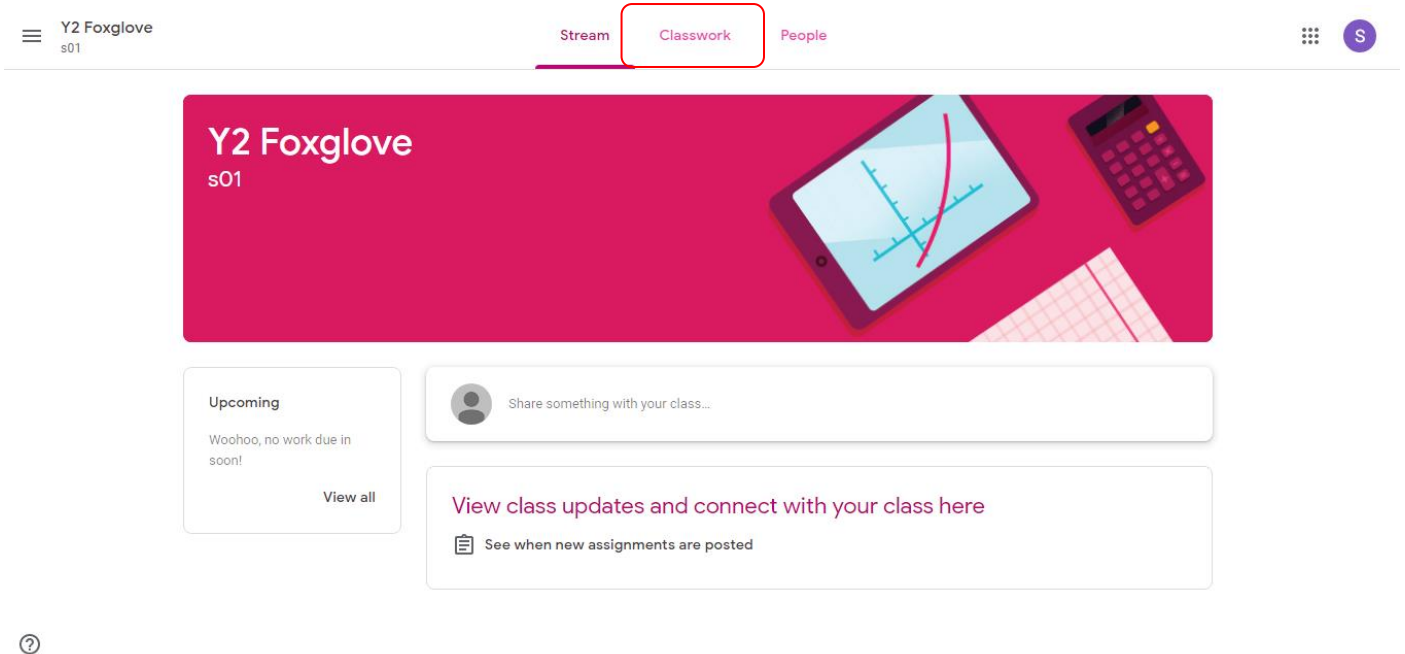
10. Select the correct class from any that are shown.



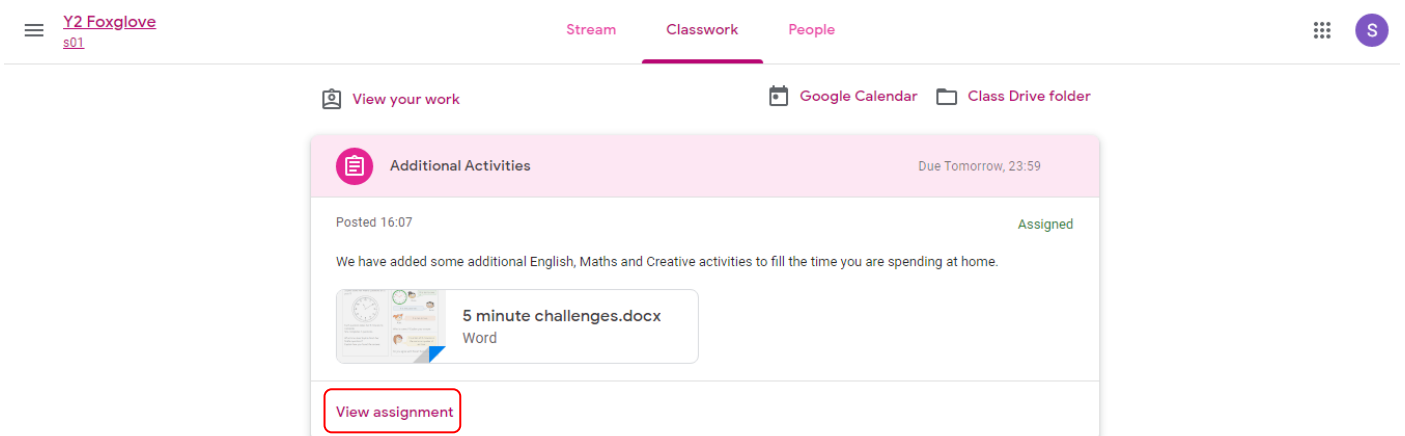
11. This will open up this screen and you can select tabs to navigate to different pages.



The *Stream* tab works like any homepage. This is where the teacher can post messages and children/parents can pose questions about the tasks that have been set. Notifications will also appear here when new activities have been added. This platform is for discussion about learning and not be used as a social networking page.



The *Classwork* tab is the place to go to find any daily tasks that are set. Children are able to view and download any materials they may require and when finished there is an option to upload work that is completed.





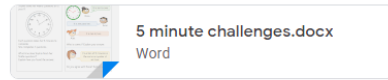
